Enrollment Application for the Westlawn Yacht Design Program

The Westlawn Yacht Design Program consists of four Modules:

Module 1 – Introduction to Yacht Design

Module 2 – Intermediate Yacht Design

Module 3 – Design of Yacht Structures

Module 4 – Design of Yacht Systems

You can start the online Westlawn Yacht Design program at any time. Our program is work- at-your-own-pace but you do not work alone! Once you enroll, you can immediately start using the online student forum to ask and answer questions, gain insights, submit lessons, and collaborate on designs and design competitions with other students, the instructors, and Westlawn alumni.

The course typically takes approximately 3200 hours to complete all 4 modules. By working 1-3 hours a day, students can expect to complete the course in 2 to 4 years. By completing all lessons and your final thesis with a grade of 75% or higher, you will earn your diploma in Yacht & Small Craft Architecture.

Throughout the program you will design 9 yachts. Your final thesis will consist of two complete professional quality yacht designs, demonstrating your knowledge and skills to design power and sailing yachts using wood, composites and metal.

You can start a module at any time by paying one fee for tuition and all required books. You then pay a small monthly fee to remain enrolled for as long as you choose to complete the course. Westlawn provides an ever expanding spectrum of valuable services to all enrolled students. These services include forum access, design consultations, unlimited cloud storage, as well as Rhino and AutoCAD software for your Mac or PC. Westlawn also offers continuing education courses, so many students elect to stay enrolled beyond graduation.

When you enroll, Westlawn will submit applications for your student membership in the Royal Institution of Naval Architects (RINA) and the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers (SNAME). If you are accepted by RINA and/or SNAME, Westlawn will pay your initiation fees and dues for as long as you remain enrolled in good standing in Westlawn.

Westlawn has no refund policy. You may withdraw at any time by informing the school, and you will no longer be charged monthly for Westlawn enrollment. Note that you will lose all benefits of being a Westlawn student by doing so. This includes SNAME/RINA student membership, free licenses for Rhino and Autocad, as well as access to your westlawn.edu email account and cloud storage.
